

ADVOCACY

Sin Barreras empowers immigrants to raise their voices and advocate for their needs. In 2025, we held **12 advocacy events**, including workshops on the electoral process, so community members understood voting rights, registration, and key election dates. All year, we **promoted civic engagement** and grew community leadership through strong grassroots organizing. We supported immigrant-led groups, coordinated with partner organizations, and provided clear direction as issues arose. Sin Barreras helped align **local efforts** and amplify a collective voice for the immigrant community.

Welcome & Navigation

A safe and trusted place for **urgent needs and information**. We help directly when possible, connect to others when appropriate, and provide a welcoming space.

- A total of **1,765 service** engagements, including **1,331 in-person** interactions and **434 remote** consultations. *Referrals and the distribution of essential resources were our most sought-after services.*

Education

Adult courses in English, Pre-GED Education in Spanish, Citizenship, Driver's Education, and Spanish Language.

- Total Number of Registered Students: **156**
- **Partnership** with **The Free Book Bus** and local organizations to provide resources to **Townwood Mobile Community**
- A collaborative **Pre-K early-education** initiative with the **Unitarian Universalist Congregation of Charlottesville**.

Immigration

Case work with non-attorney professionals accredited by the US Department of Justice to help in immigration.

- **Citizenship: 19 submitted, 10 approved** (Life of program: 160 new citizens)
- **Green Cards: 7 submitted & 2 approved, 2 renewals** (Life of program 45)
- **DACA: 22 submitted & approved** (Life of program: 245 approvals)
- **Other petitions: 34 won and pending** (Life of program 314)



Health, Wellness & Culture
